1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Player Member to the TABLE TENNIS ENGLAND Ltd or of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
2. TABLE TENNIS ENGLAND Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament including Regulation R (Racket Re-Rubbing). ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
3. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signify agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including the variations from the ITTF requirements.
4. All competitors will be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points. Play throughout will be on a knockout basis with the exception of preliminary rounds, which may, at the discretion of the Referee, be on a group basis. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. for Group competitions.
6. Competitors in Junior events must have been born in 1999 or later.
Competitors in Cadet events must have been born in 2002 or later.
Competitors in Under 13 events must have been born in 2004 or later.
Competitors in Under 11 events must have been born in 2006 or later.
7. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
8. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
9. All competitors must report to the control on arrival and must not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
10. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event.
11. Competitors will not be allowed to glue up with in the confines of the Centre under any circumstances.
12. The referee's decision shall be final on points of law, and any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final.
13. Every player must hold a valid Table Tennis England Player Licence or have paid the appropriate Single Competition Licence Fee with their entry form unless he/she provides proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated the ITTF and not affiliated to Table Tennis England.
14. No refunds will be given after the date of the draw.

1. Entry Form - Further entry forms are available from, and should be returned to Kevin Wray, Kensington Gardens, and Darlington, DL1 4NG. Cheques and postal orders should be made payable to Darlington Table Tennis Academy. Entries without fees will not be accepted.
2. Entries - If it is necessary to restrict entries this will be done on the bases of the last received, first out. The draw will take place at 19.00 on 6th May at 5 Alisan Road, Carleton, Poulton-Le-Flyde FY06 7QF
3. Admission - There will be no charge for admission.
4. Playing Conditions - Play throughout will be on 10 Butterfly space saver tables with butterfly nets. White Butterfly 3 star Polly Ball, Taraflex flooring and general fluorescent lighting a minimum of 6m above the table. Court size will be 9m x 5m (x) enclosed by surrounds. Scoring machines will be used for all matches. Assistant umpires will not be appointed.
5. Doping - Doping control tests may take place.
6. Practice - There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the Referee.
7. Car Parking - Car Parking (at owners risk) is available at the venue.
8. Refreshments - Light refreshments will be on sale.
9. Prizes – Trophies will be awarded to all Winners & Runners Up and 3rd place except junior plate.
10. Notification - Competitors will be notified of the time of their first match together with directions to the venue.

No entry will be accepted unless the following undertaking is signed:

1. To observe the regulations of the tournament.
2. To abide by the decisions of the Referee and Organising Committee.
3. To fulfil the schedule of play arranged for me unless prevented by circumstances beyond my control and accepted as such by the Referee.
