### **Regulations**

1. All matches to be played in accordance with the laws of table tennis as sanctioned by the ETTA.
2. All matches will be controlled by an umpire, whose decision will be final on points of fact. The referee's decision will be final on points of law and the interpretation of these regulations.
3. The championships are open to all registered members of the Darlington Table Tennis Academy
4. In order to maximize the number of games played the organiser will endeavor to play each event on a group basis; however will still retain the right to resort to a straight knockout if necessary.
5. In the event there are insufficient entries in a boys or girls event the umpire will amalgamate both events
6. Players are allowed to enter three events only
7. Players must report to the control table on arrival and be available to play as indicated in the published draw.
8. The loser of each match must umpire the next match on that table
9. No gluing up will be allowed in the sports centre whatsoever. Contravention of this regulation may result in immediate disqualification.
